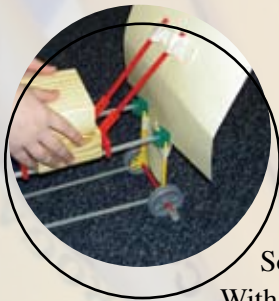

Research has clearly established that one caring adult in a student's life can make all of the difference. Both the student and the mentor experience positive growth. Students who have this opportunity to be in a caring mentor relationship have increased academic performance; increased enthusiasm for learning and school bonding; and improved attendance and social behavior.

Mentors need to be positive role models, caring, dependable, understanding, good listeners, patient and trustworthy.

At least once a week, you and the student may read, do homework, share a hobby, eat lunch together, talk or just listen. Sign up at the lobby Ministry Opportunities Desk to further investigate the possibility of a mentor relationship with a Hiatt Student.
